## Weather Policy

Pool will be closed when rain interferes with the performance of the lifeguards. Pool will re-open when the manager on duty deems it safe.

**Thunder & Lightning** -If thunder is heard or lightning is spotted, the pool will be closed and the deck will be cleared. The pool will remain closed for 30 minutes. Management reserves the right to close the pool and grounds for extended weather events. The pool will reopen when weather conditions improve in the area.

Please remember that all members' safety is of the utmost importance. These weather rules are not only for your protection and well-being, but also for the pool staffs' safety and well-being.

## Safety Information

1. Red Cross or Coast Guard-approved flotation devices are strongly suggested for children who do not know how to swim.
2. Children under 38" tall must have a parent or sitter in the water at all times. Flotation devices WILL NOT be accepted as a substitute for a parent or sitter.
3. The Pool Manager, Lifeguards, and Board Members have the authority to enforce safety and health regulations and to maintain good order. This shall include authority to evict offenders from the Club property.
4. It should be noted that Pool Staff are not to be considered baby-sitters. Children between the ages of 8 and 12 must have a 2011 Permission Form on file in the pool office before any child can be left at the pool without adult supervision. It should also be noted that the child must be able to swim the width of the pool before the Permission Form can be approved by the Manager. These rules are in place to ensure everyone's safety.
